We want our students to feel supported by us. We will not impose our beliefs on our students. We will listen. Before we can support our students, we need to support each other. With the help of some of our teachers, we've compiled a list of resources, resources for educators to fight racial inequality. We encourage you to use these resources for your self-care, to educate yourself with the **facts**, and to learn how we can support each other and our students.

In the long term, CHSLSJ leadership is committed to seeking organizations that will help us dismantle the systems of injustices that our staff and students are up against... to help us build equity and address social injustice in our community. We look forward to collaborating with our staff in search of these organizations.

We don't have all the answers. Yet, in our vision, CHSLSJ commits to Excellence, Empowerment, Inclusion, Acceptance, and Responsibility, continuously engaging and inspiring our students. We follow our vision without wavering. We encourage all members of our school community to reflect on the work that they do and how it aligns with our vision and mission in order to best support the fight against systemic racism. Each member of our community must be fully committed to this mission and our vision if they plan to remain. We need allies in the fight against racial injustice. We will not censor our support of Black lives and people of color. We are committed.
